## DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS: 24 MARCH 2024

The COST Action CA18232 "Mathematical models for interacting dynamics on networks" invites applications for Virtual Mobility (VM) Grants to support virtual collaboration and networking capacity within the scope of the Action, more specifically, to support the following types of activities, or similar:

- To prepare online surveys and other materials needed for the final report;
- To coordinate the preparation and production of the WG white papers;
- To prepare the platforms and other resources necessary to support the long-term existence and activities of the network beyond the end of the Action.

Applications should be submitted via the e-COST platform by **23:59 CET on Sunday**, **24 March**, **2024**, grant applications will be assessed on a case-by-case basis until the deadline is reached or the available funds have been used. Every effort will be made to communicate the results of the application withiin three working days of submission. **Activities must be completed by 3 April**, **2024**, the last day of the Action.

Applicants may apply for any amount up to the maximum of  $\in$  1500 permitted by COST rules, and only the documentation required by COST (completed application form and CV) needs to be uploaded to e-COST.
